Publication Policies I.

- All projects need to be discussed and approved by (at least one) WG
- All approved projects need to be announced to the collaboration (eROPUB)
- At the beginning, everything is a project, but every project should be assumed to lead to a paper
- “Parent” projects can have more than one “child” paper.
- Some project can lead to no papers, but we should avoid “orphan” papers as much as possible

Publication Policies II.

- All members of the collaboration can see all announced projects/papers
- Every member of the collaboration can request to be part of a project/paper, “with the presumption that permission will be granted if she or he has made any significant contribution to the specific research project.”
